Tickets for events are usually sold on Kide.app.



STUDENT ASSOCIATIONS

Student associations take care of local advocacy and organizing student events. Moreover, you can order your overalls from the student association of your campus and participate in numerous events!

The student association for the Business field is Trombi ry. You will hear more about Trombi's activities and membership levels at the orientation days! The student associations in technology fields are HTO ry and UIO ry. Student association for electrical and automation engineers is AOK ry. ESN Metropolia operates in all the campuses in Metropolia as a student association of and for international students.



STUDENT OVERALLS

Student overalls are overalls that are mainly used at student events. Overalls are usually worn by students in universities of applied sciences and universities. Metropolia has 15 different overalls for students in different fields. Most of the overalls are sold by student associations. Some study groups acquire their overalls themselves at the beginning of semesters. METKA does not sell overalls. Overalls cost 1-50 euros depending on the field of study.

Fabric patches are collected in the overalls to commemorate various events. You can also buy patches. In addition to METKA and student associations, individuals sell patches at student events or online.

The coloring of the overalls and the logo of the educational institution, student union or student association on the back indicate the place of study and the degree program. Among students it is common to exchange the overall leg with your significant other and a sleeve with your friend. Overalls are usually worn tied at the waist.

The overalls have landed in Finland via Sweden. The overalls were first worn by technology students in universities (teekkari) in Finland. Overalls have since spread to university of applied sciences students as well.

Tuudo and student card

With the Tuudo app, you can access METKA's announcements, your schedule, academic records, the weekly menu of the school canteen, a map of the campus and more! There you can also find your electronic student card which gives you access to student discounts. Install Tuudo even before the orientation days: <u>tuudo.fi</u>.

HSL travel card

You will get a student-priced HSL travel card with a certificate stating your recidency within the metropolitan area (Helsinki, Vantaa, Espoo, Kauniainen). You can get the physical HSL card from their office (<u>hsl.fi/asiakaspalvelu</u>). Take a HSL form with you. You can get the form from the reception of your campus. You can also download the HSL app on your phone. However you can only buy normal priced single tickets with the app.

Healthcare

All foreign students (who are not EU citizens or citizens of Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein or Switzerland) who come to Finland for the purposes of studying are required to have a health insurance, if the studies endure longer than three months. Exchange students can use public healthcare services. Finnish Student Health Service (FSHS) is for degree students only.
